Professional Experience

Tim became an Of Counsel member of Marts & Lundy upon being named Vice President for Development at Stanford Hospital & Clinics in July 2009. He had joined Marts & Lundy as a Senior Consultant in 2008 following a 21-year career in Stanford University's office of development.

Tim began his development career in foundation and corporate relations during Stanford's Centennial Campaign, the nation's first \$1 billion campaign. He served as chief architect and campaign director for Stanford's two most recent campaigns – the \$1.1 billion Campaign for Undergraduate Education and The Stanford Challenge (currently well on its way to reaching its goal of \$4.3 billion).
